

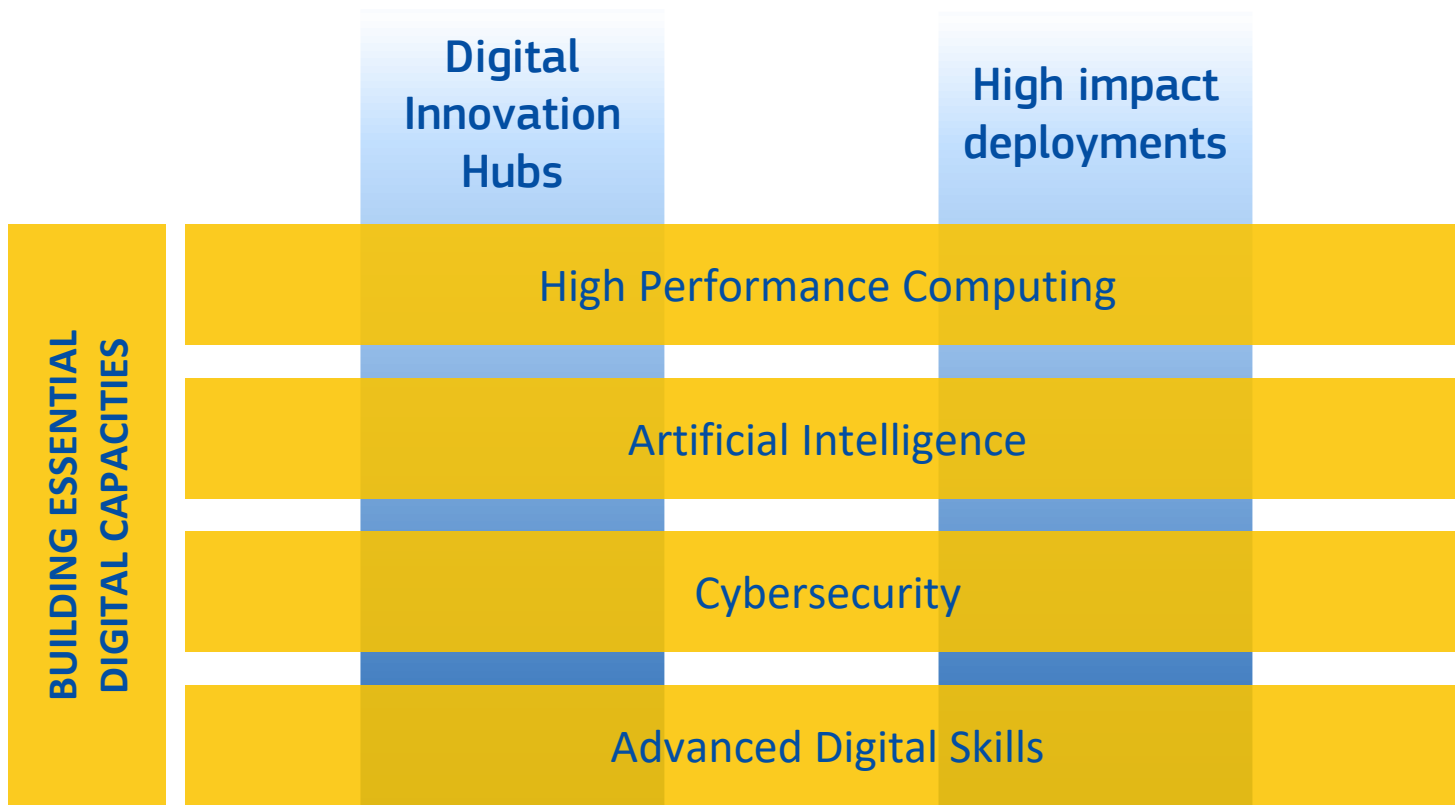

Work Programme 2021-2022

Work Programme 2021-2022 published on 10 November 2021

1st Call

- Specialised Education Programmes in key capacity areas (Master's courses)
- Coordination and Support Action (CSA) on skills analysis

2nd Call

- Short-term training courses, including Crash Courses for SMEs
- CSA on Digital Transformation of Education

3rd Call

- Specialised Education Programmes in key capacity areas (Master's courses)



Focus on DIGITAL Master's

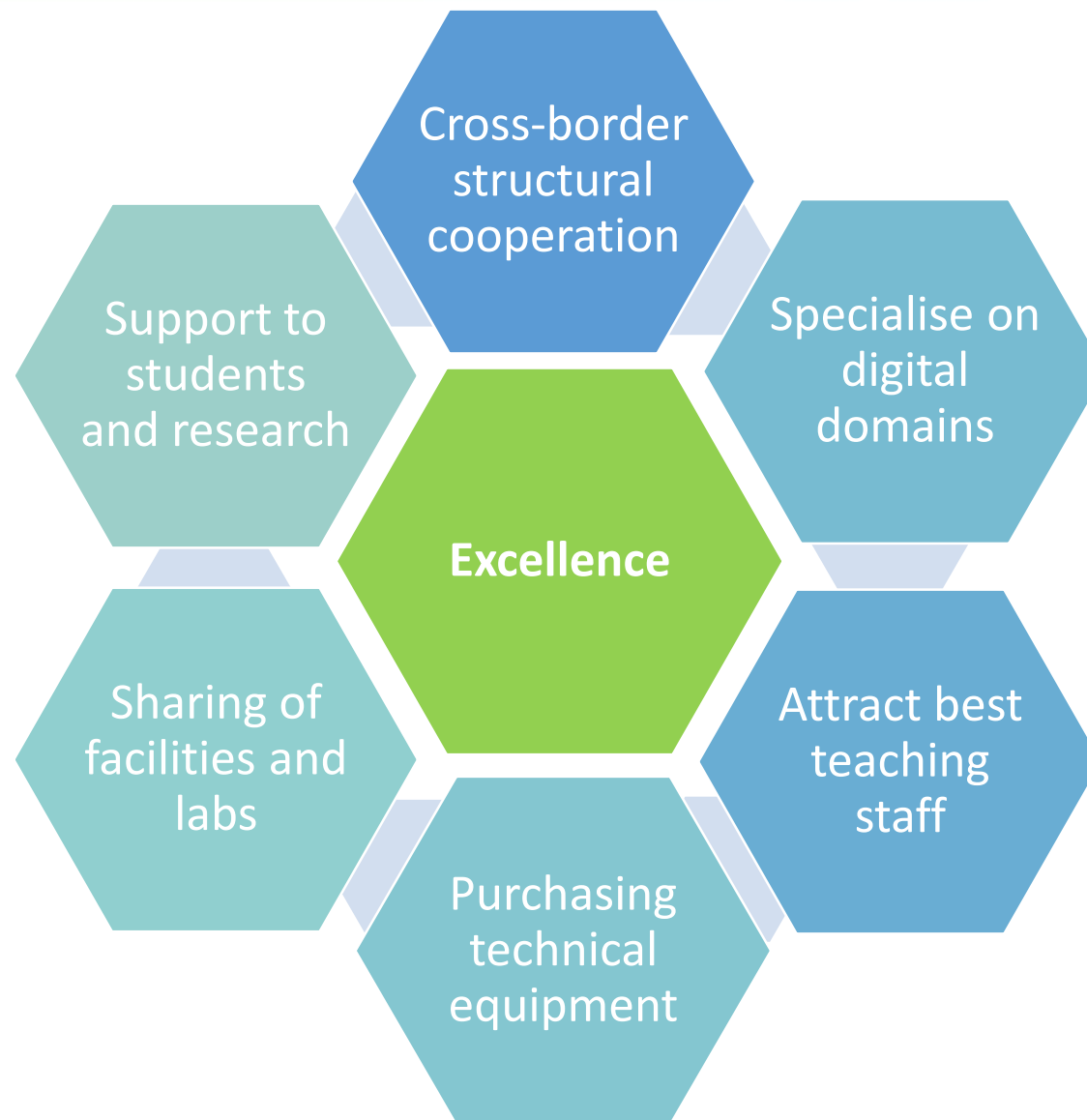
Type of action	Simple grant (50% co-funding rate)
Indicative Budget	EUR 122 million for the first two years
Timing	First (EUR 70M) and third call (EUR 52M)
Indicative duration of the action	48 months
Indicative budget per Grant (EU contribution)	EUR 5-10 million
Implementation	Executive Agency (Hadea)
