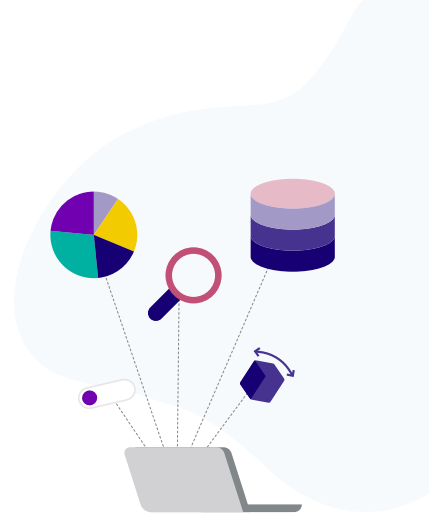


# Types of Digital Jobs Out There

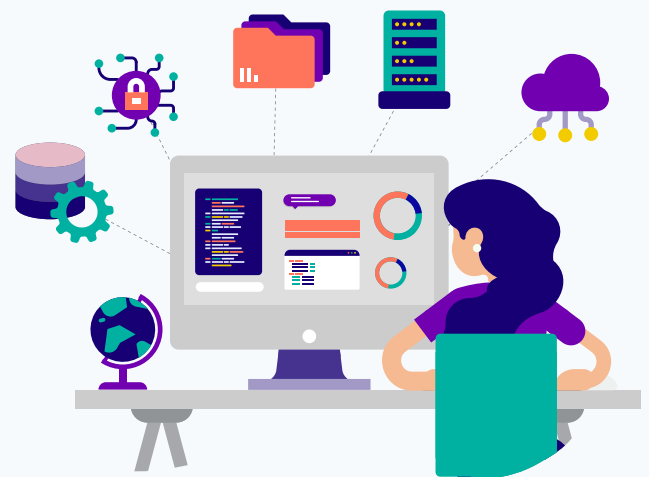
The EU has developed labour classifications (ESCO) and specific reference frameworks (e-CF) to offer a common language to define digital jobs – and the skills needed to perform them.

## ? What are the main types of digital jobs?

We can broadly split digital jobs in **3 main categories**, depending on how intensively they use ICT.

### ICT-intensive jobs

These jobs revolve around ICT and cannot exist without the corresponding digital services, products, or technologies.

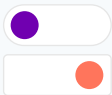

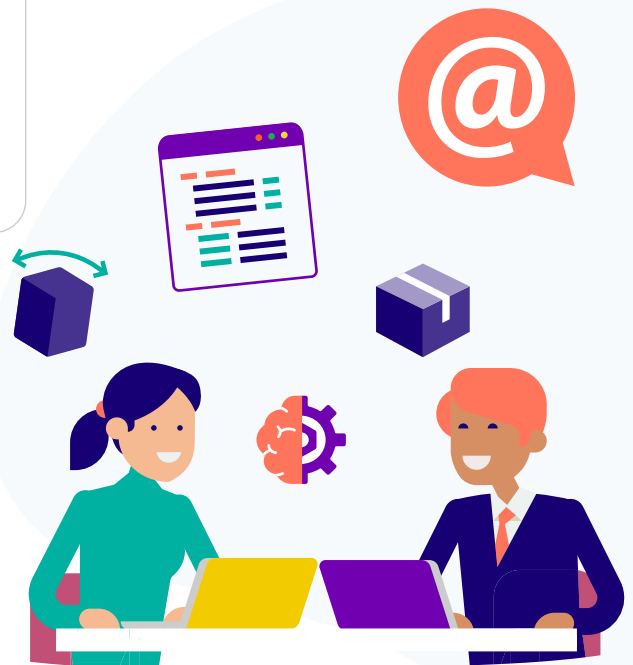
