

Types of Digital Jobs Out There

With digitalisation permeating all areas of life, digital jobs – or jobs, where digital technologies play a main role - appear across all industries and sectors. **As more and more work activities rely on ICT**, the number (and variety) of digital jobs is growing steadily. The EU has developed labour classifications (ESCO) and specific reference frameworks (e-CF) to offer a common language to define digital jobs – and the skills needed to perform them.

• What are the main types of digital jobs?

We can broadly split digital jobs in **3 main categories**, depending on how intensively they use ICT.





ICT-dependent jobs

Jobs that use digital technologies to some degree at least. While ICT has made those jobs possible, key skills from other disciplines are needed here.
