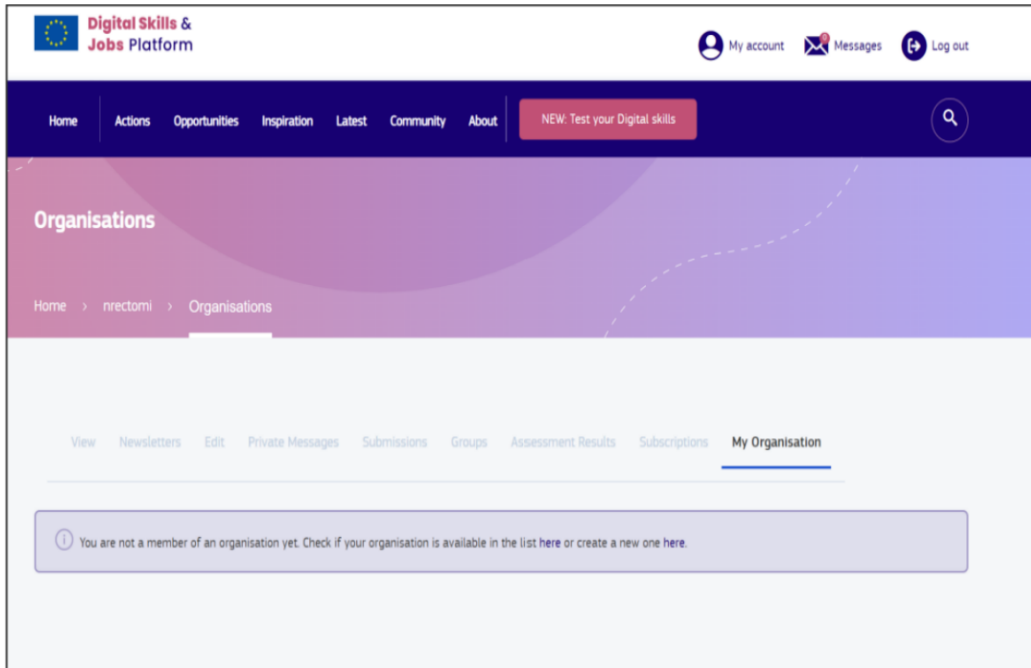

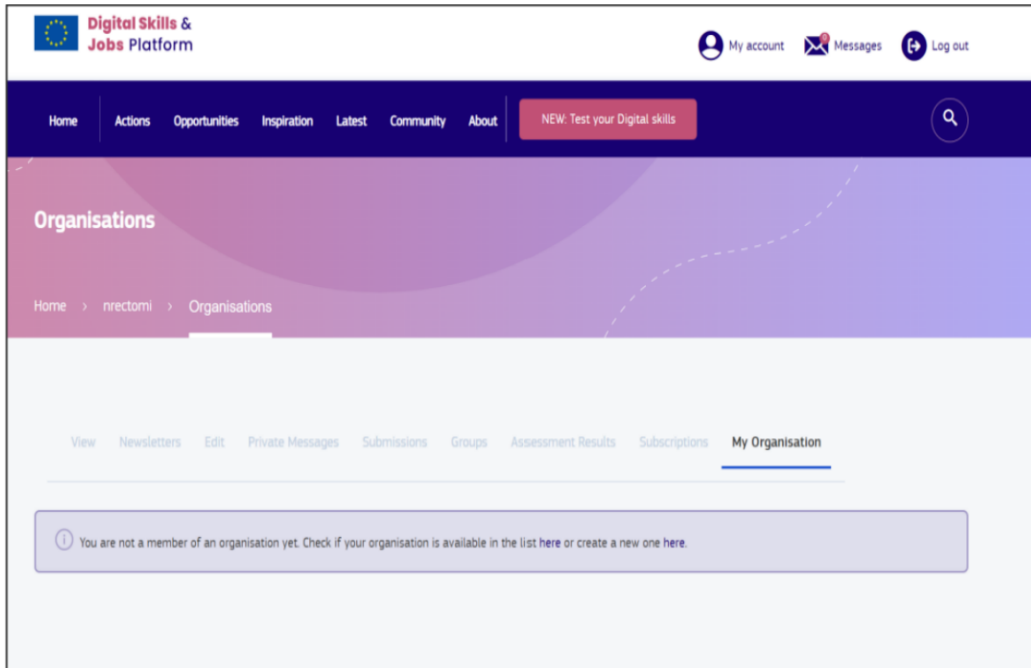


# Your organisation does not have a profile in the Platform



- ▶ Go to your personal profile (when logged in, the link “**My account**” is in the top left bar)
- ▶ Click on **My Organisation** tab. You will see the following message: *You are not a member of an organisation yet. Check if your organisation is available in the list [here](#) or create a new one here.*
  1. Please, search [the list](#) of available Organisations first. If your Organisation is not there, proceed to create a new profile for your Organisation.
  2. Go back to your Profile/tab Organisation and click on Create a new organisation. You will be redirected to the form
  3. Fill in the form and submit the profile for approval by clicking on the Create organisation and Become a member at the bottom of the page

1. Access the Organisations listing page by clicking on “[Check if your organisation is available in the list here](#)”

4. The Owner is the **contact person** of the organisation
5. The contact person/owner is automatically notified by email that a membership request was received and will proceed to assess and possibly approve the request.

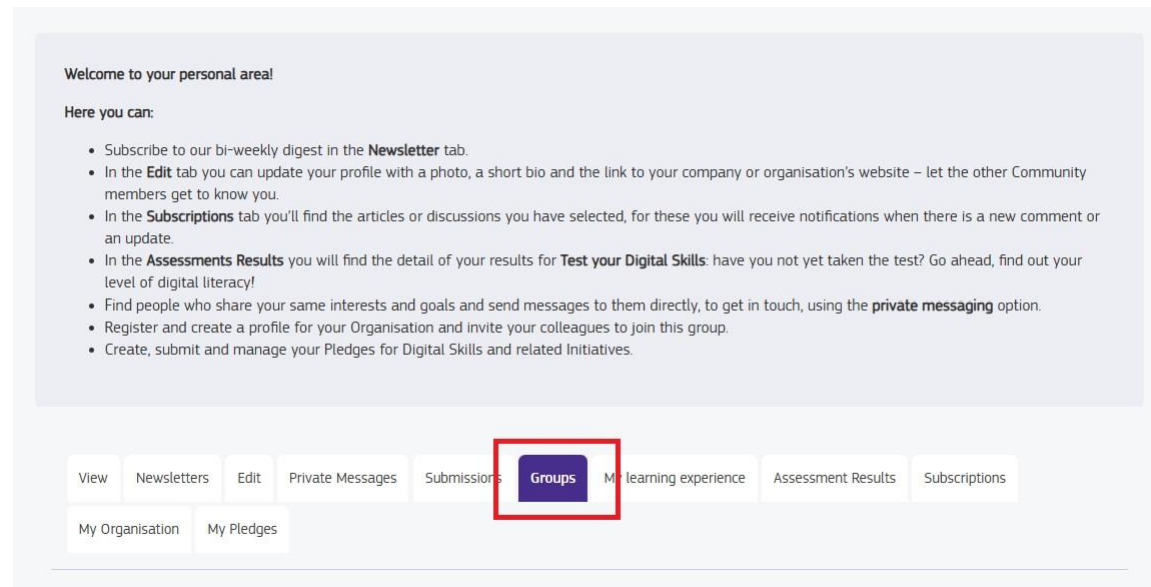


# About the community group

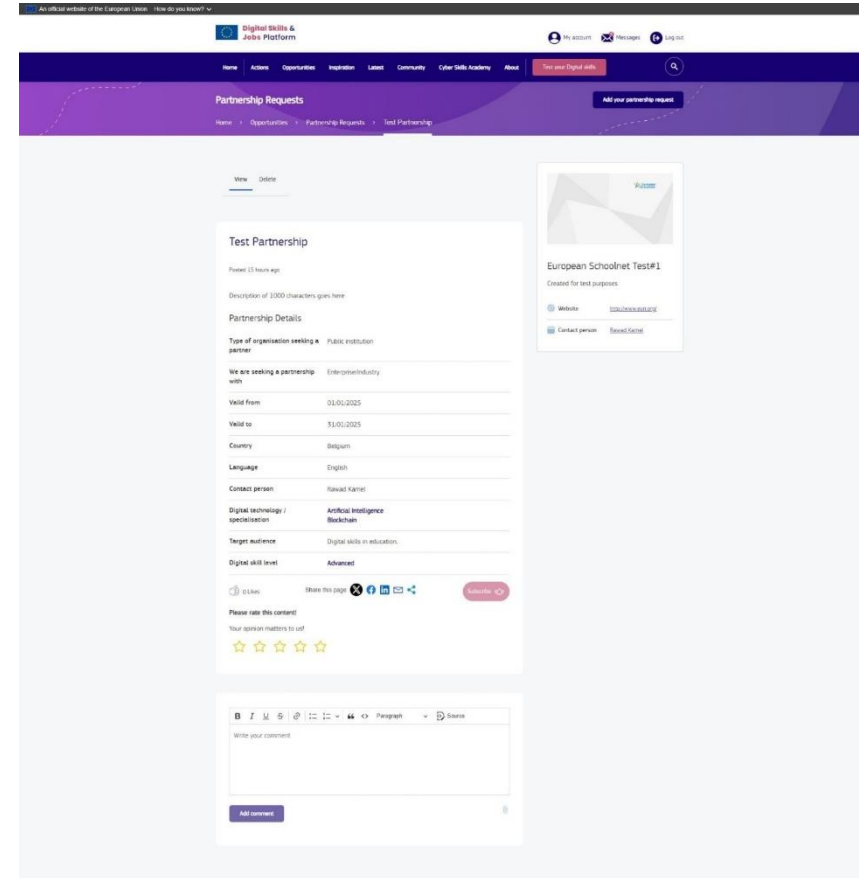

# Contact Information

- ▶ **Maintain an Updated Contact Person:** Ensure your organisation's **contact person** is updated.
- ▶ **Add More Contacts for Partnership Requests:** Only one email address can be registered per organisation. If you wish to indicate more points of contacts for your organisation, please use the community group
  - ▶ Click “**Start a Discussion**” and title it: “[**Your Organisation**] – **Points of Contact for Partnerships**”.
  - ▶ List the relevant **Points of Contact** for your organisation.

# Connect Directly

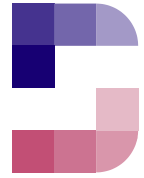
- ▶ Search through the [Organisations directory](#) to find a partner. If you find organisations that you wish to contact, simply use the contact details indicated in profile.
